“Well, we’re striking for our lives and we’re striking for our health and our safety and for the lives of our loved ones. Amazon is putting us in a real difficult position. To the world they’re saying that we’re heroes, but inside of the warehouse walls they’re treating us like we’re disposable, like we’re trash. They’re putting us in a real hard place. [...] There’s all sorts of situations that they’re putting us in to ship the goods that people need. But it’s also angring because a lot of the stuff that we’re shipping is not essential.”
